Let's try to give others the respect and attention they deserve!



Attentiveness Craft THE DEER'S EAR Make a deer's head with movable ears. Color the deer's head and ears before cutting them out. Fasten the ears to the head with brass fasteners so the ears can move. **Points to Ponder:** Ears must point in the right direction to listen. • Eyes must be open to see. Mouth must be quiet so you don't distract others. **Additional Supplies:** Scissors, markers, brass fasteners

MAKE A MAGNIFYING GLASS

Cut out two magnifying glass frames, preferably on heavy paper. Place a piece of kitchen plastic wrap between the frames, and staple the frames together. Trim the extra plastic wrap from the outside edges.

Spread a newspaper on a table and place your magnifying glass over a color picture. Put a small drop of water on top of the plastic wrap, and the water drop should magnify the picture underneath in order to see many small colorful dots.
